FOIA Fees:

The first 50 black and white copies are free. Thereafter, each page will be charged \$.15 per page. Each color copy will be charged at \$.25 per page. Persons requesting electronic or oversized copies will be charged at the actual cost to the District for reproduction. Fire report requests are assessed a flat fee of \$5.00 per document. Ambulance report requests are referred to Sherman Hospital, the Bartlett Fire District's system hospital. Each certified record shall cost \$1.00.

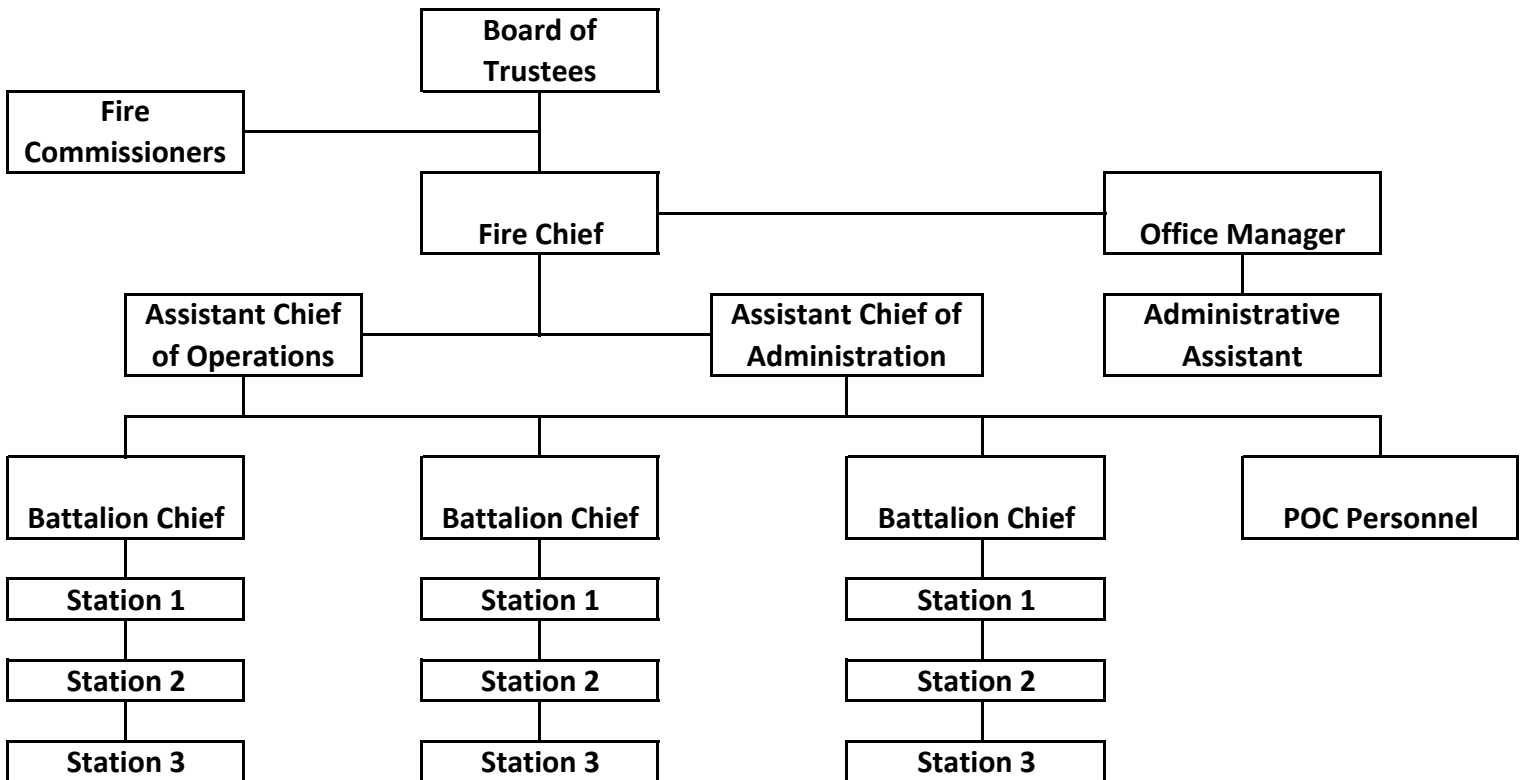
